### First Day of School is August 17<sup>th</sup>. Full Day--8:35 AM to 3:35 PM.

Breakfast will be served from 7:45 to 8:20 AM. Corsica/Stickney students will eat breakfast before leaving to school site. The morning student transport bus to will leave at 8:10 AM Sharp from each town. Note any student wanting breakfast---Serving will end at 8:20 AM. The PM shuttle will leave Corsica at 3:10pm and go to Stickney, arriving approximately 3:25pm. The shuttle will return with students arriving in Corsica approximately 3:40pm.

### Breakfast Prices: K-12--\$1.75 (20 meals=\$35.00), Adult--\$2.15 (20 meals=\$43.00)

### Lunch Prices: K-6--\$2.65 (20 meals=\$53.00), 7-12--\$3.10 (20 meals=\$62.00), Adult--\$3.65 (20 meals=\$73.00)

## VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS

South Dakota requires all  $\delta^{\text{th}}$  grade students to get:

 One dose of Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap) vaccine on or after the 11<sup>th</sup> birthday

 One dose of Meningococcal (MCV4) vaccine on or after the 11<sup>th</sup> birthday

For more information, talk with your family physician or your local community health nurse about these and other vaccinations your preteen should receive.




Health Nurses will be providing flu shots again this fall with students at a later date.


