Notice: the school buildings at both campuses will be open at **7:45 AM** for students.

Please **DO NOT** drop off students before this time as we do not have staff available to supervise.

On days we have a **10am start**, breakfast *will not* be served and the shuttle buses will leave from their respective towns at 9:30am. School buildings will open at 9:15am...please do NOT send/drop off students before that time.

First Day of School is Tuesday, August 16th. Full Day--8:35 AM to 3:35 PM.

Breakfast will be served from 7:45 to 8:20 AM. Corsica/Stickney bus students will eat breakfast before leaving to school site. The morning student transport bus to will leave at **8:10 AM Sharp** from each town. Note any student wanting breakfast---Serving will end at 8:20 AM. The PM shuttle will leave Corsica at **3:10pm** and go to Stickney, arriving approximately **3:25pm**. The shuttle will return with students arriving in Corsica approximately **3:40pm**.
