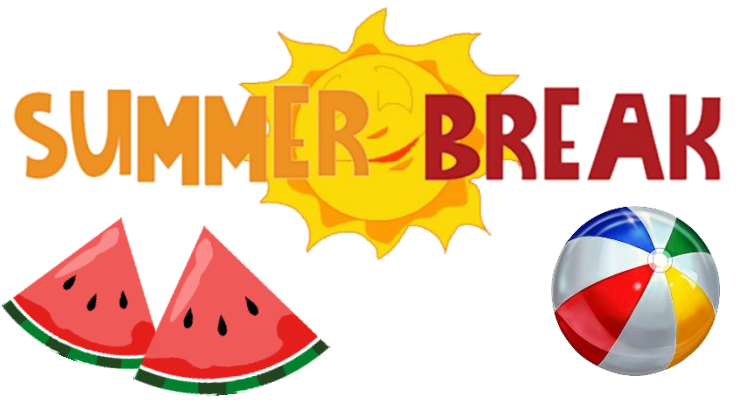

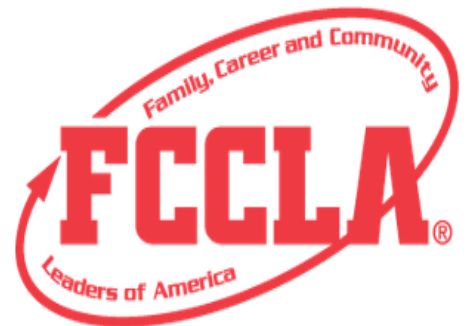
Sioux Falls, SD – From April 27–29, 2025, Family, Career and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA) members from across South Dakota gathered in Sioux Falls for the annual State Leadership Conference. 1400 members, advisors, alumni and special guests were in attendance. The three-day event was packed with dynamic workshops, STAR events (Students Taking Action with Recognition), general sessions, and social activities that inspired, challenged, and connected members. Attendees also took part in meaningful service projects, further demonstrating FCCLA's commitment to leadership through community impact.

A major highlight of the conference was keynote speaker Harvie Herrington, a former NFL player turned motivational speaker, who delivered a powerful message about discovering one's purpose and helping others rise to their full potential. 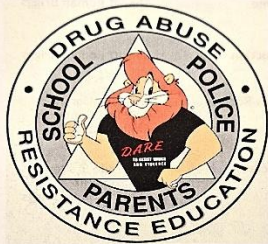


Flag Etiquette Lesson
