Alto saxophone players chosen were Lorie Pickart, Kris Bordewyk, and Holly Rexwinkel. Diane Moke and


Swing Choir and Stage Band Traci Wahlert fill the tenor saxophone spots and contributes Plooster baritone saxophone.
