The Corsica Comets had a good season finishing 11-8 and tied for 3rd in the conference with a 5-3 record. The Comets averaged 50.7 points per gameand 35.7 rebounds. The opponents averaged 44.3 points

Corsica shot 41.2% from the field and 56% from the free throw line. The Comets were led by Troy Bosma who shot 67% FT and 45% FG, scored 263 points, and had 201 rebounds. Bosma also made 2nd team All-Conference. Jeff Buntrock, who shot 63% FT, scored 197 points and had 96 rebounds, Scott Menning who shot 43% FG, scored 149 points and had 99 rebounds, Dale Uttecht, who shot 73% FT, had 127 points, and 135 rebounds. Uttecht also made third team All-Conference.
